

Primitive Bunny Ornie Pattern



Supplies:

½ yard of homespun (your choice of color)
¼ yard of orange flannel (or anything orange)
6 buttons for eyes
DMC floss (I used brown)
Needle/floss needle
polyfil
Instant coffee
Cinnamon
vanilla
Liquid starch

This pattern is so quick and easy and FUN! First you cut out the bunny pattern, pin it to the desired fabric for your bunnies, CUT 2. If you want 3 bunny ornies, CUT 6. And cut out the orange noses, 1 for each bunny.

Then sew your bunnies together, leave the bottoms OPEN, then snip around the edges, and in between the ears. Turn and stuff, **DO NOT STUFF ALL THE WAY UP THE EARS...**only go up an inch or so...and stuff the rest of the bunnies. Then sew up the bottoms.

Next I used DMC floss to sew on the button eyes, I started where I knew the nose would be, so you can cover the knots with the orange nose. After you get the eyes on then I use

the same floss and stitch ALL the way around the orange nose. Then after the nose is on, for the whiskers, I took some more floss and went through the mouth area (side of the nose on the bottom) 3 times, and knotted them together on one side, then knotted them on the other side, so they stay in place. Cut the whiskers to the desired length.

Finally the FUN part!

You mix in a bowl, **STRAIGHT** liquid starch, **NO WATER**, and mix in a little of instant coffee, I do about a teaspoon at a time till I get the color that I want, then a dash of vanilla and cinnamon. I just wing it on that part, everyone likes it differently! ☺ Stir it up good.

Then I dip my bunnies in the mixture, and soak the tops of the ears really good, the parts with **NO** polyfil in them. I then lay them the way I want on my cookie sheet, and scrunch up the ears the way I want them to be. Oh and fix the whiskers the way you want them to be also. Then I put them in the oven, (200-300 degrees) I have a convection oven, which works great, less burning. **But PLEASE be careful baking your primis! It can be very dangerous. So please do this at your own risk!** You can also put them outside to dry, or in the house. Then you have Primitive Bunny Ornies! Enjoy!
